

SUB:- PERMISSION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF FLORENCE NIGHTINGALE
SCHOOL OF NURSING, BIDAR.

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1. The inspection report of the Karnataka Nursing Council, has been received for starting of Florence Nightingale school of Nursing, in Diploma in General Nursing & Midwifery by Khan Education Society of Bidar. For establishment of Nursing School, it does not have 150 bedded hospital, does not have its own building and has shown different nursing homes. Since it is not in accordance with the rules of Indian Nursing Council and Karnataka State Nursing Council, the said proposal has been rejected, as it is not fit to run the Nursing School. Accordingly, vide Govt. Letter Dated 28-11-2001 in file No. HFW/182/MME/2001, the proposal has been rejected.
2. There after, in the letter dated : 27-8-2002, the aforesaid society has requested for permission to start the aforesaid Nursing School, for the year 2002-2003. vide Govt. Letter, Dated 19-9-2002, the Director of Medical Education has been instructed to inspect the said nursing school and submit its inspection report. As per letter, Dated 23-10-2002 of Director of Medical Education, the inspection report has been submitted before the Government with a proposal to sanction of nursing school. In the inspection report, from the academic year of 2002-2003, the inspection committee has proposed for sanction of Nursing School with a limit of 50 students admission.

3. The Khan Education Society, Bidar has been permitted to run Florence Nightingale School of Nursing with a limit of 50 students admission, in Diploma in General Nursing Course, from the academic year 2002-2003, This permission is granted with the following conditions.

CONDITIONS

1. To take approval from Karnataka State Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council
2. To abide by the working plan of Indian Nursing Council and Karnataka State Nursing Council fixed syllabus and midwife and Nursing Examination Board.
3. To abide by the rules of the Karnataka State Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council.
4. To provide essential facilities as per the directions of the Indian Nursing Council.
5. To abide by the instructions of Government, Karnataka Nursing Council and Indian Nursing Council.
6. The education Society will not be given aid by the government for any reason.
7. The education society has to appoint eligible candidates having experience of teaching and non-teaching staff.
8. To provide all relevant books and periodicals in the library for Nursing and medical subject.
9. to give preference for girls students for admission and reserve only 5% of the seats to the Boys students.
10. To submit the report of self hospital constructions.
11. To abide by the conditions of the investigation committee of the Karnataka Nursing Council Strictly.
12. To take admission as per rules of 2001's Karnataka Diploma in General Nursing for Midwifery/Psychiatry Nursing Courses, to the students,
